**RE: CIVIL PARTNERSHIPS**

Thank you for contacting me about the Homelessness Reduction Bill, which I fully support.

I wish to congratulate my Conservative colleague, Bob Blackman, for bringing this Bill to Parliament. The Bill will provide significant support to those who are about to or have already been made homeless.

As you may be aware, the Bill will place a new duty on councils to support those who are homeless. Councils will be required to help those threatened with homelessness or who are already homeless find a home.

I am glad that this Bill, which has secured Government backing, is protecting homelessness prevention funding for councils. Central funding to tackle homelessness is also being increased to £139 million and this will include targeted funding for rough sleeping.

I fully support the Bill and expect to do so when it returns from Committee to the full House. Thank you again for taking the time to contact me.
