ABOUT THE RESPONDENTS



The majority of people who responded are a parent/guardian of a primary school aged child/children. Followed by parent/guardians of a secondary school aged child/children.

Grandparents living in the village were also keen to share their thoughts with me.

PRIMARY SCHOOLS




93% of parent/guardians of a primary school aged child/children reported that they attend one of the primary schools in the village.

96% were happy with the primary school their child/children attends and many respondents had very positive things to say about the primary schools in the village.

SECONDARY SCHOOLS








72% of those who were not allocated a preferred secondary school appealed the decision with West Sussex County Council and of this 72%, 60% of them were successful in the appeals process.




94% of parent/guardians are happy with the secondary school their child/children attends and 85% are happy with the pastoral care offered by their child/children's school.


Do You Support or Oppose Single Sex Education?
